Sample Itinerary

Day 1: Overnight in Eastern Pennsylvania. Before arriving, visit Bill's Bike Barn, a true collection of vintage motorcycles and Americana memorabilia. www.billsbikebarn.com

Day 2: Continue to Salem, MA for our next (2) nights. A small city, Salem attracts visitors from around the globe. Most noted for the Salem Witch Trails of 1692, Salem's history stretches from the 17th century to today. Dinner on your own on the beautiful Salam Wharf. Day 3: Start with a historic trolley tour of Salem, learning about the witchcrafts trails 1692 and Salem's literary and maritime history. Next visit the Salem Witch Museum, which examines one of the most enduring and emotional events in American History, the Salem witch trails of 1692. www.salemwitchmuseum.com Enjoy some lunch and browsing downtown. This afternoon visit The house of the Seven Gables, one of America's most beloved historic homes. It is best known today as the setting of world-renowned American author Nathaniel Hawthorn's 1851 novel. Dinner included.

Day 4: No visit to Salem is complete without a visit/tour of Peabody Essex Museum. Museums offer us an environment in which people, ideas, life experiences, and feelings can come together across time, place, and cultures. A visit invites us to explore our complex, rapidly changing world through the power of the arts and cultural expressions. www.pem.org Continue to South Yarmouth, Cape Cod for (3) nights. Enjoy oceanfront lodging at the Red Jacket Beach Resort. Dinner included. www.redjacketresort.com

Day 5: A tour of the Cape highlights our morning. Learn about the legendary history and see the beautiful, natural, unique landscape of Cape Cod. Visit the John F. Kennedy Memorial and pay tribute to the nation's 34th president. Visit St. Francis Xavier Church and hear the history of the church and its relationship with the Kennedy family through the years. Drive the length of the peninsula's arm with stunning views along Cape Cod National Seashore. Arrive in Provincetown and enjoy lunch in this charming village. After lunch head out to sea for a whale watch expedition. The trip is designed to enhance our awareness of whales, other marine life and the marine habitat that surrounds us. A naturalist on board gives a presentation about the whales, their behavior, and some of the other marine life common to the area. Back at our resort dinner is included.

Day 6: Board a ferry for beautiful Martha's Vineyard. The jewel of New England is a tour highlight. See Gay Head, famous for its National Landmark lighthouse and multi-colored clay cliffs. Oak Bluffs is home to many historical and nationally recognized landmarks and boasts hundreds of imaginative and colorful gingerbread cottages containing the most perfectly preserved collection of Carpenter Gothic style architecture in the world. A sightseeing tour of Martha's Vineyard showcases these and many other memorable sights. Spend some leisure time in Edgartown, one of New England's most charming communities. Ferry back to the mainland later afternoon for an included dinner to conclude a delightful day.

Day 7: Visit the New Bedford Whaling Museum and enjoy a guided tour. www.whalingmuseum.org Last night in Scranton, PA Day 8: Visit the Houdini Museum & Magic Show. A guided tour is included, plus a video he made in 1918 and a magic show by Dorothy Dietrich and Dick Brookz, American magic royalty. Late morning continue homeward.
